The United Way of Baldwin County Board of Directors recognizes that all students have talents and skills that can be directed towards service and leadership. While this is not a merit-based program, there are minimal requirements in order to be considered. Applicants must maintain a 2.5 GPA and be in good attendance standing at their school.

To be eligible for a possible scholarship and/or a letter of recommendation at the end of the program, each Youth Board Member will participate in the events (subject to change) listed below:

- Attend at least one scheduled board meeting and all youth board meetings (located throughout the county) including Baldwin Youth's Task Force meetings
- Attend allocation reviews (two full days—TBD)
- Help fundraising efforts at schools during campaign season
- Participate in soliciting donations for in-house events (for example children's books, Christmas project, diaper drive, etc.) and other events or programs as scheduled

The goals of the Youth Board are below:

- Inspire youth to become leaders in our community
- Educate and increase awareness of the community need among the younger population
- Encourage philanthropy and volunteerism at a young age
- Increase involvement and understanding of United Way of Baldwin County among youth
- Offer a lesson for life in giving back to our community
